SPREADING THE WORD

MAKING THE MONEY

Startup Costs: Where will you get money to start your business (i. e. savings account, loan from family, etc.)?

I will receive my startup costs from my parents, who have agreed to help me with the start of my business.

Materials: What materials will you need for your product or service (fliers, business cards, posters, equipment, tools, etc.)?

I will need lemons, ice, water, sugar, a pitcher, cups, and a table and chair for my stand.

Cost of Materials: How much will the materials cost?

20 pounds of lemons - \$39.20 *this does not include taxes*

Ice, water, a pitcher, and a table and chair will be found and home and not paid for.

Cost Per Unit: What is the cost of making EACH product or providing EACH service?

\$39.20 + \$15.99 + \$6.88 = \$62.07 for 200 servings of lemonade

\$62.07 / 200 servings = \$0.31 per serving

Pricing: How much will you charge? Make sure you set your price above the cost per unit.

I will charge \$0.75 per lemonade.

Profit: How much will you make on each sale after you subtract your expenses?

I will make \$88 on 200 sales after expenses. \$0.75 - \$0.31 = \$0.44 \$0.44 x 200 servings = \$88

Profits Plan: What will you do with the money you make? Will you buy more supplies? Donate? Save? Make a plan for spending, saving, and sharing.

All of the money I make, after paying the expenses, will go to buying more supplies and donating to Produced With Purpose to support their mission of inspiring young people to create a business just like mine!
